Ambulance Wish Singapore is a registered charity incorporated in May 2019 that supports terminally ill patients and their loved ones through the simple but deeply meaningful act of wish-granting. Ambulance Wish Singapore is an Institution of Public Character (IPC).

By helping to fulfil these wishes, Ambulance Wish Singapore wants to transform the end-of-life experience for patients with a limited prognosis of less than 12 months, giving them and their families a measure of joy, peace and comfort.

As a volunteer-led organisation, the work of Ambulance Wish Singapore is an extension of the provision of care for the dying that goes beyond the walls of hospitals and hospices, to impact homes and hearts.

Our work is rooted in our motto, "Fulfilling Wishes, Celebrating Lives".

To create positive end-of-life experiences for terminally ill patients through the fulfilment of their final wishes.

Our Vision

To transform the end-of-life experience of terminally ill patients and their loved ones, beyond basic palliative care services.

REFER A WISH



These are the steps involved in wish requests.

1. Form must be completed and signed by the patient, next-of-kin, or official referrer (physician/medical social worker).



2. Wish Eligibility – Ambulance Wish Singapore will do the necessary checks to confirm whether the patient is medically eligible to receive the wish.

Anyone aged **19 and above** who has **<12 months prognosis**. This includes those with:

- **End-stage conditions**, eg organ failure and late-stage cancer
- General frailty and co-existing conditions with death expected **within 12 months**
- Conditions that put them at risk of dying from a sudden acute crisis
- **Life-threatening acute conditions** caused by sudden catastrophic events
- Is Singaporean or Permanent Resident
- Has not previously had a wish fulfilled by Ambulance Wish Singapore

Patients who may be eligible to receive a wish can be referred by:

- Medical professionals (eg doctor, nurse, allied health professional, medical social worker)
- Family members with detailed knowledge of patient's current condition

A patient may also apply for a wish directly by filling in the form found in the above button.

3. Determining the Wish

Ambulance Wish Singapore assigns a team of volunteer wish granters to explore the wish request.

With the assistance of medical social worker/wish referrer, wish granters will have a chat with the patient/next-of-kin to determine the details.

4. Granting the Wish

Once the wish has been confirmed, Ambulance Wish Singapore sets out to create a memorable and meaningful wish experience for the patient.

We strive to give timely attention to all wish requests and will liaise closely with the patient's healthcare team to ensure that their health condition allows the wish plan to be carried out.

What Can You Wish For?

Wish requests typically fall into these four major categories. The possibilities, however, are endless because each patient is unique.




I wish to go...

those who mean a lot to me, like my spouse, favourite television personality, childhood friends, or pet



I wish to have...

a meaningful experience, like a gathering or staycation, an outing, a photoshoot with my loved ones, or something special (eg riding a sports car, attending a concert, going on a yacht)



I wish to give...

back to society through a fundraiser of my own, or leave a legacy (eg recipe book, personal biography, art exhibition)

BEHIND EVERY WISH

When Care Goes Beyond the
Salon Chair: Vivian's Story

A JOURNEY THAT CHANGED EVERYTHING

At 55, Vivian has spent most of her adult life helping people feel good about themselves. A full-time hair stylist with 30 years in the industry, she runs Hair Destination at Blk 84 Redhill Market.

It was her mother's illness that led her to discover a different kind of service — one rooted not in scissors and styling, but in compassion, presence, and heart.

In 2023, Vivian's mother was diagnosed with cancer and came under the care of the [Singapore Cancer Society](#). A volunteer had introduced the family to Ambulance Wish Singapore (AWS). Vivian saw first-hand how AWS volunteers went above and beyond to create meaningful experiences for her mother — from a carefully planned outing to [Bird Paradise](#) to a restful staycation at [Mandai Rainforest Resort by Banyan Tree](#). Every detail was thoughtfully arranged, taking her mother's condition into account so she could simply relax and enjoy the moment.

For Vivian and her family, those experiences were priceless.

Seeing her mother laugh, smile and feel valued — even briefly — made Vivian realise how powerful these moments could be. It also sparked a desire to give

back so that other families could experience the same comfort and joy.

GIVING COMFORT, ONE CUT AT A TIME

Vivian now supports AWS by sharing her professional skills when needed. While her involvement has been on an ad-hoc basis, the experience has taught her new ways of working.

Attending to patients with mobility challenges or sensory sensitivities means adapting her usual cutting techniques — slowing down, adjusting positions, and being extra mindful of comfort. It's a different pace from a busy salon, but one she finds deeply meaningful.



A SHIFT IN PERSPECTIVE

Volunteering has changed how Vivian views giving. What once felt like simply offering help has become something more thoughtful and intentional. Through supporting patients and witnessing the dedication of AWS volunteers, she's learnt that even small gestures — when given sincerely — can bring dignity, comfort and joy. The experience has made her more empathetic and patient, and reminded her that giving back is a shared journey.

For those who may be hesitating to offer their skills or time to AWS, Vivian has a simple and reassuring advice.

You don't need special talents or grand gestures to make a difference. What matters most is a willing heart and the courage to begin. Besides, AWS provides guidance, support and a strong sense of community — no one walks the journey alone.
